This was not an easy decision to postpone the event for the second year in a row. The Kenosha County Historical Society Board of Directors and the Homecoming Car Show Committee have met and deliberated for many months. Many different factors have been taken into consideration including that the vaccine distribution process takes time and its unknown right now what travel guidelines may hinder the ability for some of the car collectors from outside of Wisconsin and/or outside of the United States to travel here. In order for the large scale and high quality event to take place that the public has come to expect, a postponement is necessary. The health and safety of the attendees, volunteers, staff, and community must come first.

The car collectors, car enthusiasts, volunteers, and other attendees of the Kenosha Homecoming Car Show are what makes our event so special.
